

**Barri-Kir@** is a light brown liquid. It is a synthetic pyrethroid to control and repel flies and other insect pests in animal houses and on animals (pigs, cattle, dogs, horses, birds and goat) by either dipping or spray. It is also used to control mosquitoes, houseflies, cockroaches and other insect pests in public health.

**For Poultry:** After disinfecting, spray **Barri-Kir@**(1-2 ml per litre of water) inside and outside the building, in crevices and cracks and spots where insects can breed. Apply in presence of birds and on litter, when and as required.

**For Cattle:** Apply either by dipping or spray.

For dipping: 1<sup>st</sup> Fill: Use 100 to 130 ml per 100 L water

Refill: 150ml per 100L water

For Spray: Use 100-130 ml per 100 L water. Apply every 15 days or when and as required.

Do not use on lactating cow.

**For Sheep, goat and pigs:** Spray (1-2 ml per L of water) in and around pens in the presence of animals, avoid direct contact with feedstuffs.

Withdrawal period for slaughter: 8 days.

**For Public health:** Spray 1- 2 ml **Barri-Kir@**per L water in non-food areas in schools, hospitals, food processing plants, hotels, industrial buildings and stores. Cypermethrin is toxic to aquatic life and is important to avoid contamination of water surfaces.

**Toxicity:** Acute oral LD<sub>50</sub> for rats 79-400mg/kg

**Antidote:** Typical Symptoms expected: headache, tremors, nausea and sweating.

**First Aid:**

**Skin:** Wash off immediately with soap and water, repeat rinse thoroughly.

**Eyes:** Irrigate eyes with clean water for at least 15 minutes; seek medical aid.

**Swallowing:** Induce vomiting by tickling back of throat or administering a mild emetic such as salt water. Seek medical aid.

**PRECAUTION:**

- Keep away from reach from children.
- Do not mix with other chemicals
- Avoid contact with eyes and skin during spray. Wear gloves and goggles. - Dangerous to fish. Do not contaminate ponds, waterways or ditches.
