DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply with a bulb duster or dust gun into insect breeding sites and harbourages. Insert the nozzle well into harbourages and pump gently to minimise contamination. Apply at close spacings to ensure good distribution. Clear up any dust contaminating exposed surfaces. Apply in ducts using a motorised duster.

Application rate: Surface application - apply to give a light coverage.
